

## Field Trip Health Presentation

**Age Focus:** Recommended for Pre-Kinder up to 3rd Grade.

**Overview:** Health Presentation that focuses on our organs, including the heart, lungs, and stomach and how to keep them healthy. All Stuffee resources are aligned with current TEKS standards.

**Length:** Program presentation is approximately 20 minutes long. The students will be divided into small groups and take turns visiting the Museum's different zones and engaging in the Stuffee Health Presentation in the Auditorium.

**Cost:** A 20 minute Workshop Craft or Stuffee Presentation is included with the regular field trip admission price of \$5.00. If your school opts for the Discounted Group Rate, they will NOT be able to participate in a workshop craft or Stuffee presentation.
